Since Covid-19 emerged to a pandemic in 2020 many governments around Europe have taken extreme measures of lock down. Teachers had to teach from home suddenly for the first time, students required to continue learning from home for the first time and parents had to support their children becoming in some ways a home teacher. This new reality found most teachers, unprepared to adapt their teaching, creating, learning and living habits and be as productive and effective while staying at home.

In order to help address this, the ONLIFE Erasmus+ project aims at empowering teachers and school leaders to face the digital transformation of the educational system in times of crisis.

POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS DEVELOPED BY THE CONSORTIUM

We're excited to share the ONLIFE policy recommendations with our community! These recommendations were developed by the ONLIFE project consortium to support educators in adapting to rapid changes in the education landscape. The recommendations cover a wide range of topics, from digital literacy and professional development to student engagement and assessment. They are a valuable resource for anyone working in education and provide practical guidance for navigating the challenges of online, hybrid, and blended learning environments.

Further to the above, the report provides a framework and guidelines for improving teaching quality in School Education, with a focus on enhancing digital tools and environments. It includes a theoretical framework, guidelines for implementing hybrid learning techniques during times of crisis, and policy recommendations based on case studies and training tests. Special consideration is given to e-learning quality requirements, professional development training for instructors, and promoting inclusion, diversity, and innovation. The report aims to sensitize School System Bodies to their responsibilities and help them define clear quality policies for teaching in the digital environment.
